The Journey Center offers a variety of resources and experiences in Christ-centered spirituality, healing and wholeness:

- *spiritual direction* (a person meets with a spiritual director regularly to learn to notice and respond to God's voice and the work of the Spirit in their lives)
- *prayer, journaling and other spiritual practices* (group gatherings; classes, groups, workshops and retreats; praying for individuals on site and at festivals/markets)
- *a focus on health and healing of the whole person* (healing prayer services; health-related classes, groups and workshops; counseling; support/recovery groups)
- *ministries of compassion, mercy and justice* (we will be a center for various ministries that reach out to the poor and unfortunate with practical and compassionate help, and we will invite people to join us as we do this)
- *music and the arts* (an emphasis on these as pathways to encountering God, as well as avenues of expressing our God-given creativity)
- *places to build relationships and grow in community* (discussion groups, bookstore, reading room, café, small groups, retreats)
